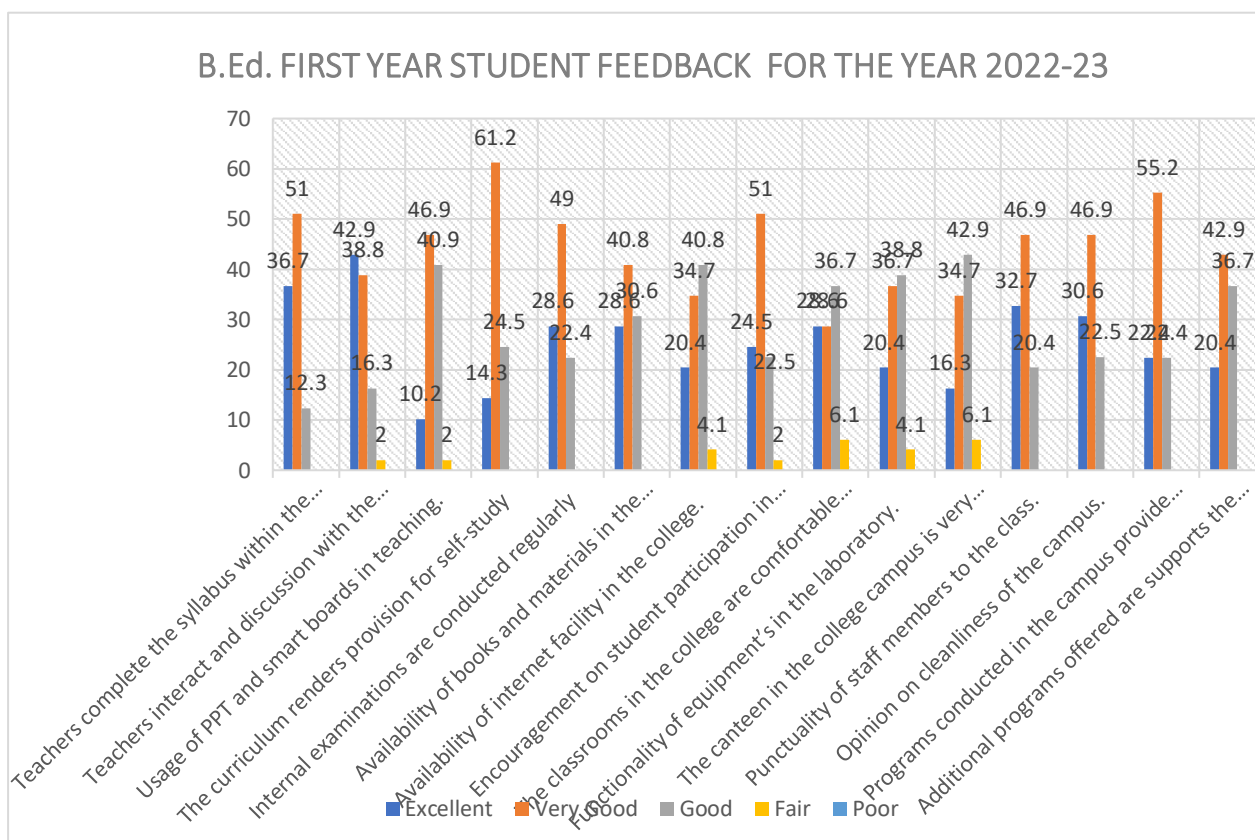

3. Expanded canteen menu.

Action taken report based on student Feedback:

- Necessary repairs and upgrades to ventilation were identified and completed to ensure better air quality and comfort for students.

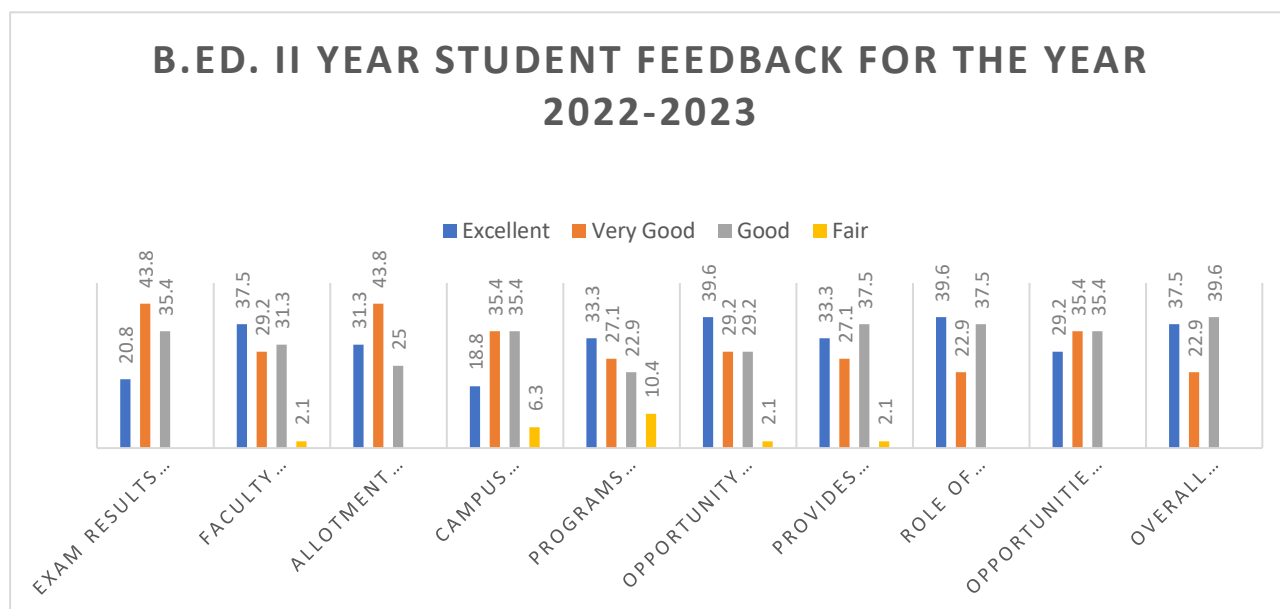
3. Expanded Canteen Menu:
