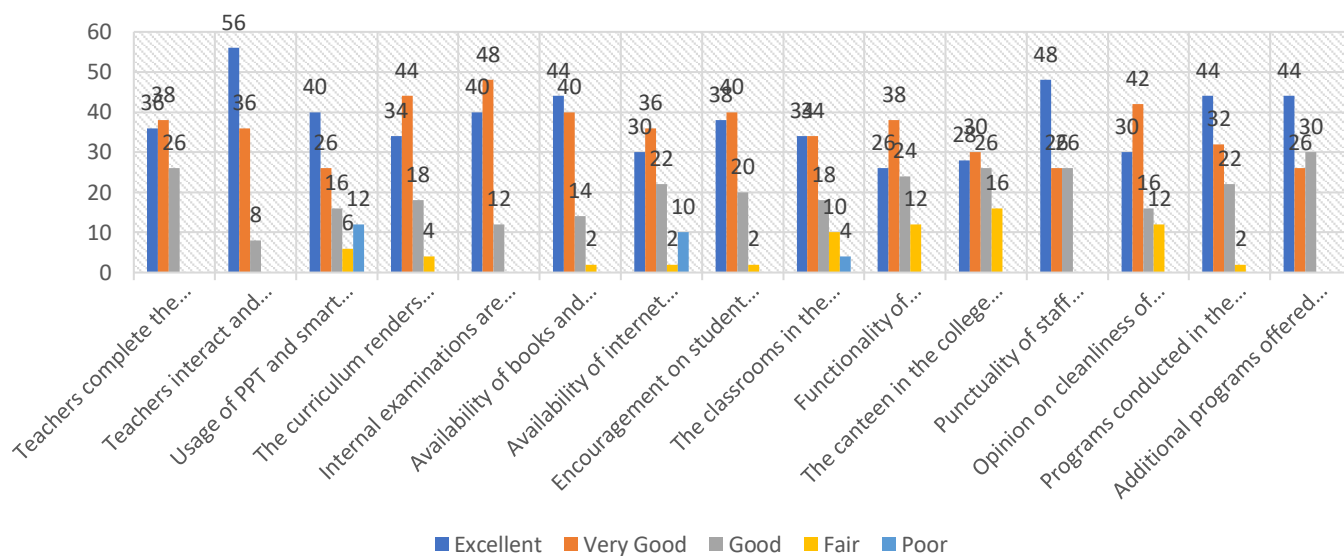

S.NO	STATEMENT	INFERENCES
1	Teachers complete the syllabus within the stipulated time	36% of students selected excellent, 38% of them selected very good and 26% of them good.
2	Teachers interact and discussion with the students.	56% of students selected excellent, 36% of them selected very good and 8% of them good.
3	Usage of PPT and smart boards in teaching.	40% of students selected excellent, 26% of them selected very good, 16 % of them good, 6% Fair and 12% poor.
4	The curriculum renders provision for self-study	34% of students selected excellent, 44% of them selected very good and 18% of them good and 4% fair.

The feedback provided by the students on the course material, instructional strategies and institutional resources is analysed in this study. The feedback is collected from the 50 students of B.Ed. first year. The students were highly satisfied with the resources available in the institution. Many students expressed satisfaction with the relevance of the curriculum to cope up with the current scenario. The majority of students appreciate the faculty members for their punctuality and timely completion of the syllabus. A significant portion of students reported overall satisfaction with the institution. Some of the recommendations are proposed by the student. Areas that require attention and improvement are cleanliness of the classroom, increase the usage of technology and to improve the canteen hygiene.

Actions to be taken:

The following areas are to be concentrated on the basis of feedback received from the students.

1. Improvement of classroom cleanliness.
2. Enhance usage of technology.
3. Ensure canteen hygiene.

Action Taken Report based on Student Feedback

1. Improvement of Classroom Cleanliness:

- Implemented a revised cleaning schedule to ensure daily cleaning of all classrooms.
- Additional Supervisor is appointed to ensure daily cleaning of classrooms and the surrounding.

2. Enhanced Usage of Technology:

- Provision of additional resources such as projectors, smart boards, and educational software.
- Encouragement of faculty to use online platforms for assignments and discussions.
- Upgraded existing classroom technology infrastructure, including projectors and interactive whiteboards.

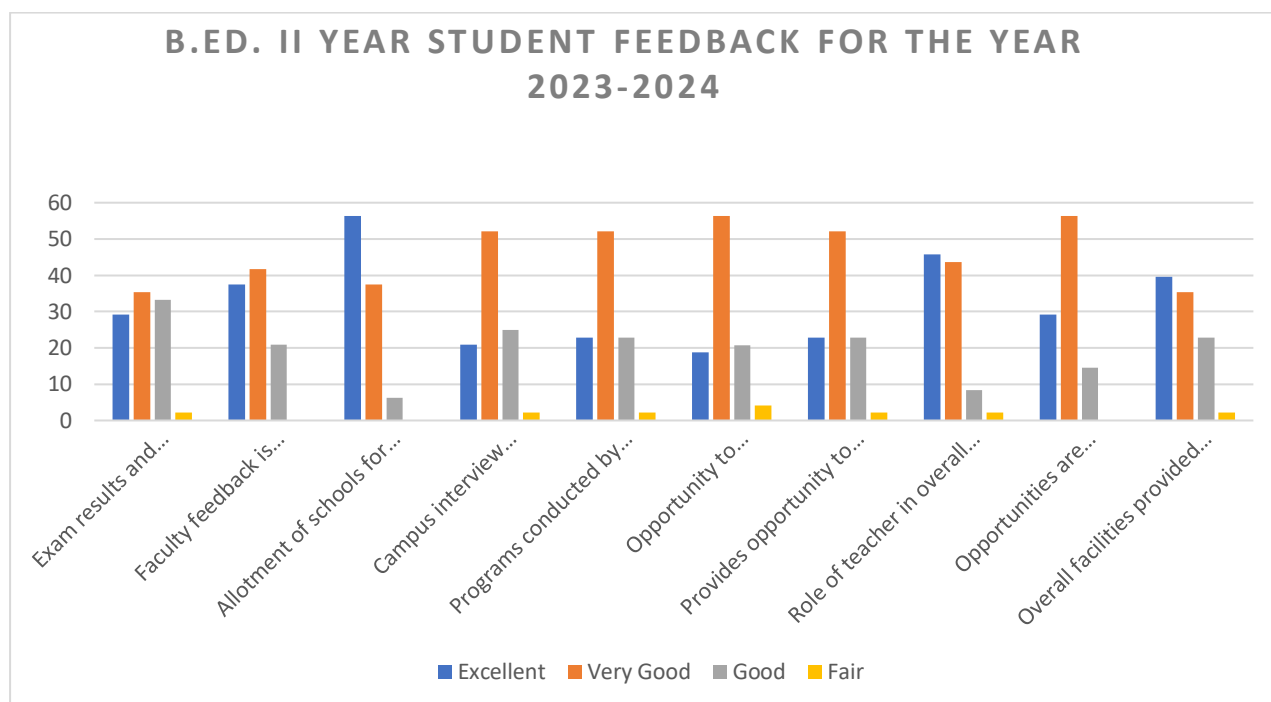
3. Enhancing Canteen Hygiene:

Action Steps Taken:

Increasing Schools for Campus Interviews:

- Identified and contacted additional schools, colleges, and educational institutions to participate in campus interviews.
- Scheduled and organized regular campus interview sessions with participating schools to expand job placement opportunities for students.
- Conducted career readiness workshops and mock interview sessions to prepare students effectively.

Increasing Number of Textbooks in the Library:

- On 22.05.2024, we procured 15 copies of textbooks based on student recommendations received during the sessions. Furthermore, in accordance with

students' feedback, we plan to increase the number of reference books and textbooks in the coming years.
